Assessment

Candidates are progressively assessed throughout the course on each practical element of training and given constant feedback. Candidates will also have to pass a multiple choice on-line examination.

Requirements

In order for candidates to be able to hold an SIA CP licence they must be able to provide evidence of an in-date acceptable qualification in first aid (minimum of First Aid at Work/FPOS).

Candidates will also be assessed for a base level of fitness which will demonstrate they will be able to perform the role of a Close Protection officer effectively.
